RULES

1. **See Open Class Division General Rules on page 20.**
2. You may enter the Waukesha County Fair Open Class Beef if you live in Wisconsin.
3. Entries in this division close June 1. Application and fees must be filed with the Fair Office on or before June 1.
4. Only two premiums per entry number.
5. Each exhibitor must furnish their own feed and bedding and be responsible for their cattle. (No bedding furnished by Association.)
6. If a partnership animal is entered in a single class that animal may be shown by only one partner in groups except where ownership is not requested.
7. All animals must be registered in the herd book of their respective breeds and at least four months old at time of exhibit.
8. All animals entered must be owned by the exhibitor for at least 60 days before close of entries and at time of show.
9. Junior exhibitors must exhibit animals other than those shown in Junior show classes.
10. All entries must be in place by 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday. Cattle will be required to stay for the full time of the fair. Release time will be at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday.
11. Entry fee will be \$7.50 per animal, non refundable.
12. Campers must register with the Fair Office.
13. **Age Classification:**
 - A **Junior calf** is one born on or after January 1 of exhibit year. The calf must be at least four months old at the time of exhibit.
 - A **Senior calf** is one born during the period of September 1 to December 31 of year preceding exhibit year.
 - A **Summer yearling** is one born during the period of May 1 to August 31 of year preceding exhibit year.
 - A **Junior yearling** is one born during the period of January 1 to April 30 of year preceding exhibit year.
 - A **Senior yearling** is one born during the period of September 1 to December 31 of second year preceding exhibit year.
 - A **2 year old and older** is one born September 1 of second year preceding exhibit year and shall have calved during the past year.
