RULES

1. Only one exhibit per entry number.
2. Exhibits will be accepted between 2:00 and 8:00 p.m. Tuesday in the 4-H Forum. No exhibits will be accepted after 8:00 p.m. Tuesday. Exhibits must be in place until 7:00 p.m. Sunday. Exhibitors must have their claim checks to pick up exhibits.
3. Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday.
4. Only non-professional artists that are Waukesha or Milwaukee County residents are eligible to enter. (Non-professional is defined as any person whose income from the sale of art work is less than 1/2 of their total personal income.)
5. Entries must be original works of the exhibitor and must have been completed within the last year.
6. No commercial kits are allowed, except where indicated.
7. Two-dimensional entries must be securely and suitably wired for hanging using picture wire and screw eyes or suitable clips and not be larger than 36" X 36". Pictures that are not on stretched canvas must be rigidly framed or they may be rejected for safety reasons.
8. All articles are exhibited at the owner's risk. The Fair Management assumes no responsibility for losses. Entries should be removed promptly after the close of the Fair. The Waukesha County Fair Assn., Inc. will take every precaution for their safekeeping, but will not be held responsible for any damage or accident that may occur.
9. Functional and Non-functional definition: Functional is intended for every day use, Non-functional is for art display only.
10. To assist in judging, attach a card to the entry tag with the following information. 1) The source of the idea for the entry. 2) Describe special techniques and processes. 3) Other considerations, such as title.

OPEN CLASS PHOTOGRAPHY

RULES

1. Only one exhibit per entry number.
2. Exhibits will be accepted between 2:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Tuesday in the 4-H Forum. No exhibits will be accepted after 8:00 p.m. Tuesday. Exhibits must be in place until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday. Exhibitors must have their claim checks to pick up exhibits.
3. Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. Wednesday.
4. Only non-professional artists 18 years of age and older and Waukesha County residents are eligible to enter. (Non-professional is defined as any person whose income from the sale of art work is less than 1/2 of their total personal income.)
5. Entries must be original works of the exhibitor and must have been completed since the previous Waukesha County Fair date. Once a photo has been entered into the Waukesha County Fair it can not be entered again. Same image should not be entered as a vertical in one category and as a horizontal in another category.
6. All photos other than those entered in Class C must be mounted on a single sturdy piece of white or black poster board only, with good photographic adhesive, such as rubber cement, dry mount or scrapbooking tape (glue stick is not recommended.) All photos 5" x 7" or smaller should be mounted on an 8" x 10" poster board. All photos
