

## CLASS O CLUB HERDSMANSHIP AWARD

Herdsmanship Awards will be made in two groups, large and small, divided according to the number of animals exhibited. The exhibit must be entered in the club name. Awards will be based on general appearance, neatness of exhibit, conduct and appearance of exhibitors, attendant in charge, storage of feed and equipment, identification of club, cattle type, quality of cattle, originality, and neatness of decorations. Decorations must not be removed before 7:00 p.m. Sunday, or disqualification or loss of award may result. It is not necessary to enter Club Herdsmanship on your entry card. Judges will be selected by the Waukesha County Agribusiness Council.

## JUNIOR GOATS

### Department 205

#### RULES

- ADGA show rules apply.
- Animals with natural horns (not disbudded or dishorned) shall not be shown except Angora and Pygmy Goats. Dairy Goat Superintendent decision is final.
- Unhealthy goats are subject to rejection at the discretion of the Dairy Goat Superintendent.
- No doe shall be exhibited with blind or non-functioning half of udder.
- There will be no pre-show milkout.
- All animals shall be in their designated pen by 6:00 p.m. Wednesday. Late Check-ins will not receive any premiums.
- Companion Goat Class exhibitors will be judged on grooming and ability to exhibit goat with collar. Animals must be owned by exhibitor.
- Any goat under one (1) year of age, born after July 1st of last year, entered in the Cart Class may be led without a driver.
- All goats in the Cart Class after 2 years of experience shall be driven unassisted.
- Cart Class Exhibitors will be judged on driving skill and ability.
- Costumes in the Cart Class will be judged on creativity and originality.
- Age Classifications:**  
A **Junior Kid** is one born on or after April 1st of this year.  
A **Senior Kid** is one born during the period between January 1st & March 31st of this year.  
A **Junior Yearling** is one born during the period of July 1st & December 31st of last year.  
A **Senior Yearling** is a dry doe born before July 1st of last year and less than 24 months of age.
- Doe that has never freshened or have not been milked regularly over 24 months compete only in the Companion Class.**

14. Only animals entered and shown in individual lots are eligible to compete in Dam and Daughter Class. Both animals must be owned by the same exhibitor.
15. Breed categories exhibiting insufficient entries may be combined.
16. All animals must meet state health regulations listed under Wisconsin County, District and State Fairs Animal Health Rules and Regulations in this book.
17. Entry fee is \$1.00 per animal (non-refundable).
18. Only two (2) managerial animals per exhibitor. Managed is one that is fed and cared for at least 50% of the time by the member but not owned by him/her or his/her immediate family.
19. Eligible Market Animals must be owned by the exhibitor.
