### Class K FIRST LEGO League Robotics Dept. 240

#### Rules for FIRST LEGO Robotics

1. Entries must use current year's FIRST LEGO League challenge.
2. Exhibitors that are not part of a 4-H FLL team may participate in entries either individually or with other 4-H members. Exhibitors can only present their individual work. In the case where the work cannot be shown individually, exhibitors must provide details to the judges clearly describing their own work.
3. No more than four entries and only one entry per entry type (project, design, programming, or robot performance). You may not sign up for both team and individual entry for a given entry type (ie. Project presentation etc).
4. Judging will be face to face and held prior to County Fair.

**Rules**

3. Sheep must have been exhibited at the Waukesha County Fair on Thursday, July 16, 2009, but can be led by someone other than the exhibitor.
4. To enter, exhibitors must sign up on Fair entry card and complete an entry form and return it to Wynn Wittkopf by Saturday, July 18, 2009.
5. Garments worn by the exhibitors may be either purchased, or constructed by or for the exhibitors.
6. Exhibitors will be judged using the Wisconsin Sheep & Wool Festival Judging Standards.

**Lamb Class:** Promotion of Lamb, Creativity, Exhibitor's Poise, Control of Animal, Presentation & Appearance of Animal
