

Waukesha County Fair Senior Citizen DEPT 140 General Rules & Regulations

1. Senior Citizen Dept. 140 Class Exhibits (entries) are limited to residents of Waukesha County, who have lived in the County for six (6) months or more during the previous or current year and have attained the age of 62 years. The exhibit (entry article) must have been produced by the exhibitor after he/she has attained the age of 62 years.
2. Articles entered in a previous year (or in a different department – Open Class, etc.) cannot be entered in Dept. 140. Exhibitors cannot enter identical articles in both Senior Citizen (Dept. 140) and the corresponding Open Class.
3. Exhibitors may enter only one item per Entry Number.
4. Entry blanks must be properly filled out and signed by the exhibitor. Entry blanks must reach the Waukesha County Fair Office, 2417 Silvernail Road, Pewaukee, WI 53072, by June 1st of the current Fair year. Entries postmarked June 1st or earlier will be accepted. Absolutely no late entries will be permitted nor will any changes or additions be permitted on your entries. Entry blanks must include ALL entries. A processing fee of \$4.00 per exhibitor must be included along with any other applicable fees.
5. All entry tags and any passes which have been purchased will be mailed to the exhibitor.
6. Entry articles will not be accepted without the entry tag issued by the fair office. **No exceptions!**
7. Entry articles/exhibits with official entry tags will only be accepted between 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Entry Day (Tuesday of Fair Week) in the Oconomowoc Room in the Arena building. **No exceptions!**
8. Awards will be made on a single judge system. Judging is done by individuals who are registered and have knowledge, training or experience in the specific classes to be judged. No article, irrespective of the number of entries in the lot, shall be awarded a higher rating than its merit would entitle it to, in comparison to the standard of perfection. Judging will begin at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday of Fair Week in the Oconomowoc Room in the Arena building and **the public is encouraged to attend.**
9. There will be a maximum of four (4) places awarded per Entry Number. There are nine (9) classes (A-I). Nine (9) Class Champion ribbons will be awarded (if the judge so designates). One Grand Champion ribbon will be awarded from the first eight (8) Class Champions. The Class I Champion, the annual special theme Class, will not be included in the Grand Champion judging.
10. Exhibits must remain in place until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday (of Fair Week). Any exhibit removed before 7:00 p.m. will forfeit the premium awarded. **Parking and admission fees will still be in effect until 7:00 p.m. on Sunday evening. Exhibits not picked up on Sunday (7:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.) may be picked up on Monday morning, following the close of the Fair from 9:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. Exhibits not picked up at the Sunday or Monday times, may be picked up on the Wednesday after the Fair at the Fair Office on Silvernail Road. Items not picked up by Monday morning will forfeit all premiums. Any items not picked up by August 1st, will become the property of the Waukesha County Fair.**

11. **The Waukesha County Fair is NOT to be held responsible for the damage to or theft of any article entered. All entries are presented at the exhibitors' risk!** Please do know that every effort is made by the Senior Citizen's committee to protect your entries from damage or theft.

Helpful Hits for Class Entries

Notice that in each Class, the last Entry Number is an "Any." The rules indicate that an Exhibitor may place only one entry in each Entry Number. To encourage more entries, this "Any" category has been included. As an example, you have entered an *Adult Sweater* in Class E Knitting, Entry #1, but you have knitted two fine adult sweaters and would like to enter them both. Rule #3 tells you that you can't enter two items under the same Entry Number. The "Any" category allows you to do this and encourages more entries.

Photography...Remember that the submitted photo must have been taken by the Exhibitor. There has also been some confusion concerning the word "Portrait." This means the picture is of a person from waist/chest up. It is not a full body shot.

Recycled...Another word that must be defined. Recycled in Entry #9 in the Class of Woodworking means that the entry must be of recycled wood or a wooden article. In Class Home Furnishing...Entry #11, recycled means any material. Note that in this case the "Exhibitor must include a description of the recycled materials used."

Knitting...Notice any machine knitted article has to be entered under Entry #10.
