TESTING FOR DRUGS

As a condition for participation in the Waukesha County Fair, every exhibitor must agree to submit any animal entered to inspection by a veterinarian appointed by the Waukesha County Fair management, and agrees to have such animal submitted to any tests as may be designated and requested by the veterinarian. Exhibitors must agree that the conclusion(s) reached by the veterinarian as to whether such animal is unethically fitted to be final. Tissue, hair and/or blood samples or carcass evaluations that yield a positive answer to tampering or an unethical practice will be sufficient evidence to remove the rights and privileges of the exhibitor(s) and to be subject to award(s) and premium(s) forfeiture, which may include auction proceeds; and/or dismissal from the fairgrounds: and/or being barred from competition immediately in the department in which the violation has occurred and/or from all departments.
