- 5. Articles which will be used outside or on the farm such as a rose trellis, chick feeder, bird house, lawn chair, etc., may be painted if the exhibitor desires.
- 6. Articles with wet paint or tacky finishes will be disqualified.
- 7. Beginner, intermediate, and advanced refers to years in project.
