1. **Please see Junior Class rules first.**
2. No more than four articles per exhibitor.
3. All articles must be made during the current year. Any work previously shown will be disqualified.
4. ALL ARTICLES MUST BE FINISHED (varnished, shellacked, stained, oiled or sealed) appropriate to use. This enables the judge to see the workmanship of the exhibitor.
5. Articles which will be used outside or on the farm such as a rose trellis, chick feeder, bird house, lawn chair, etc., may be painted if the exhibitor desires.
6. Articles with wet paint or tacky finishes will be disqualified.
7. Beginner, intermediate, and advanced refers to years in project.
