What is Junior Livestock Auction?

The 2023 County Executive and Fair Marshal's Junior Livestock Auction at the Waukesha County Fair on Friday, July 21st is the culmination of a year's project activities for 4-H, FFA, and other youth group members. As a learning and business venture these young men and women have selected, fed, and groomed an animal (steer, lamb, swine, poultry, rabbit, or goat). They have brought their project to the Fair to be judged, graded, and sold. The youngsters anticipate a better price for their animals at the auction than the going market price. Support of the auction provides recognition and incentive for young adults to earn college funds, to buy more animals, and to receive practical training in business. Buyers can support a young person in their community by purchasing an animal. Animals may be resold at current market prices if buyers do not wish to take delivery of the meat.

How to Buy

The Auction takes place in the Insight FS Livestock Coliseum, on the northeast side of the fairgrounds and is open to everyone. Interested bidders may obtain a sale sheet at the Buyer's Registration Table. The sheet contains information regarding the official sale weight, breed, and the owner of each animal. Bids are made in cents per pound with the animal going to the highest bidder (bidding on rabbit, poultry or goat is not per pound, it is per animal). If you need help in bidding, assistants at the auction will be glad to help.

Remember, if you are unable to attend the auction yet wish to purchase an animal, you may do so by filling out a Purchase Authorization Agreement and have your authorized person turn the form into the Buyer's Registration Table at the time of the sale. The Livestock Sale Committee can also assist you as a proxy buyer if so desired.

Payment for the animal should be made at the sales table. If you wish, you may be billed for the animal. Please give complete instructions as to the disposition of the animal:

- if you are picking up a live animal.
- if it is to be slaughtered for home use. Please be sure you state the name of the food processor where the animal is to be cut, wrapped and frozen. (Information will be available on custom slaughtering, cutting, and wrapping).
- if you wish to help out a junior exhibitor, but do not wish to have the processed meat, you may purchase an animal for Resale. By doing so, your animal will be sold for the current market price, and you will be reimbursed for that amount. Just check RESALE on the buyer's sale slip and the Committee will make the resale arrangements for you.

Buying the Best

Per the examples you will receive approximately that amount of meat which will be cut, well trimmed, and ready for the freezer. Prices shown are for example purposes only. Buyers are encouraged to offer bid prices at their own discretion.

For tax purposes, please note that prices paid for animals over and above current market prices are tax deductible as advertising expenses.

EXAMPLE FOR RABBIT: Meat pen consists of three rabbits live weight in 5 lbs dressed weight would be 3 lbs

EXAMPLE FOR POULTRY: On average poultry dressed weight is 25% less than live weight. So, a 40 lb. bird would have a dressed weight of 30 lbs.

EXAMPLE FOR BEEF:

A 1,200-pound live weight beef will provide approximately the following amount of dressed meat:

Steaks (T Bone, Porterhouse, Club
Steaks) 60 lbs.
Round Steak, Rump or
Sirloin Tip 15 lbs.
Chuck Roast 70 lbs.
Ground Beef 240 lbs.
Stew Meat and
Miscellaneous Cuts 45 lbs.
TOTAL 450 lbs.

If your bid is \$2.00 per pound, the animal would cost \$2,400. Processing charge (slaughter, cutting, wrapping, freezing, etc.) is approximately \$800, so your total would be \$3,200.

EXAMPLE FOR PORK:

A 230-pound swine will provide approximately the following amount of dressed meat.

Ham 32 lbs Bacon 25 lbs. Chops 24 lbs Shoulder Cut 28 lbs. Spareribs 6 lbs Sausage 16 lbs. Misc. Čuts 15 lbs TOTAL 146 lbs.

If your bid is \$2.00, the animal would cost \$460. Processing charge (slaughter, cutting, wrapping, freezing, etc.) is approximately \$285, so your total would be \$745.

EXAMPLE FOR LAMB:

A 130-pound lamb will provide approximately the following amount of dressed meat:

 Chops
 7 lbs.

 Legs
 16 lbs.

 2 Shoulders
 15 lbs.

 2 Spareribs
 5 lbs.

 Lesser Cuts
 5 lbs.

 TOTAL
 48 lbs.

If your bid is \$1.50, the animal would cost \$195. Processing charge (slaughter, cutting, wrapping, freezing, etc). is approximately \$145, so your total would be \$340.

2023 Junior Livestock Auction

- 1. Auctioneer: The Bill Stade Auction & Realty Company
- 2. Any individual, group, or company is invited to purchase any of the livestock.
- 3. **BUYERS REGISTRATION:** Your registration is for the Auction it includes all three livestock classes (steers hogs, sheep) as well as poultry, rabbit, goat, and milk. When you purchase an animal, you will be asked to sign the sales slip. **PLEASE BE SURE TO DESIGNATE WHERE THE ANIMAL IS TO BE SENT FOR PROCESSING.**
- 4. The Livestock Sale is a **CASH SALE**. Payment is encouraged immediately following the sale. All checks are made payable to: **Citizen's Bank**. Credit card payments are also accepted with a 3% convenience fee.
- 5. Bidding is on a cents per pound basis according to the live weight published on the sale order. Example: 1,000# steer bid at .50¢ = \$500; 200# barrow bid at .50¢ = \$100. Bidding on rabbit, poultry and goat is per animal (not per pound.)
- 6. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to care for and feed the animals until Sunday evening at 7:00 p.m.
- 7. Sale begins at 5:30 p.m. on Friday, July 21st.
