4. All exhibits must have an attached explanation of the types of fabric and pattern used.
5. Articles that are made over must have an attached explanation of what was done to the article and purpose of alterations.
6. Entries must be original works of the exhibitor.
7. Clothing will be judged on Wednesday.
8. Item must be finished within the last two (2) years.
9. Items must be clean, dry, and free of dirt and odor
