**RULES**

1. **See Open Class General rules.**
2. Only one exhibit per entry number.
3. Exhibits will be accepted between 2:00 and 8:00 pm Tuesday in the Arena. No exhibits will be accepted after 8:00 pm Tuesday. Exhibits must be in place until 7:15 pm Sunday. Exhibitors must have their claim checks to pick up exhibits.
4. **All exhibits except Gift Wrapping must have an attached explanation of the types of materials, tools, patterns, and techniques, used to create the item**
5. Items must be clean and free from dirt.
6. Entries must be original works of the exhibitor. NO kits unless specified.
7. Item must be finished within the last two (2) years.
8. Artificial wreaths should be made primarily with artificial materials and ready to hang. Natural material wreaths should be entered in Dept 115 - Open Class Flowers and Plants.

10. Quilt made for Christmas or Holiday, any technique, machine or hand quilted, made by individual or group
11. Any quilt done in/by a quilting circle
12. Quilt featuring machine or hand embroidery
13. Quilt using technique not listed such as rag quilt, puff quilt, cathedral window

### **Barn Quilt Division Rules:**

1. Due to display limitations, barn quilts cannot be on point (diamond shaped) and must be prepared for hanging. (Either with a hanging system, hooks, or simple drilled holes).
2. Fabric barn quilt block - must have backing, batting, and binding. Fabric block can be quilted or tied. Fabric block must be pieced, not appliqued. Fabric block can be hand-sewn or machine-sewn.
3. 4'x4' exterior barn quilt should be ¾ inch thick plywood. These will be displayed outdoors so a protective coating must be applied to the finished artwork.
