

**JUNIOR FLOWERS AND PLANTS DEPARTMENT

RULES**

1. Please read Junior Class rules first.

2. Members are to exhibit in the class which corresponds to the unit in which they are enrolled.
3. Members must furnish their own vases for flowers. PLEASE DO NOT BRING POTS OR VASES OF VALUE to the Fair.
All containers are brought at the owner's risk.
4. Potted plants should have an appropriate drain dish under the plant container.
5. Flowers are judged 60 percent on the flowers and 40 percent on the arrangement.
6. Plants must be clean and free from insects and disease injury. Unhealthy plants will be disqualified, rejected and sent home by the Superintendent.
7. House plants must be labeled with the correct name.
8. All house plant entries must have been started from slips, cuttings, seeds, or bulbs since September 1 except in Division: Plants, Class # 8-10.
9. Plant Classes 11-15 (terrariums and dish/fairy gardens) may use purchased plants but must be maintained/arranged by the exhibitor.
10. All cut flowers exhibited must be grown by the exhibitor.
11. One exhibit per entry number.
